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My research and scholarly design work lie at the intersection of community, higher-ed, and design pedagogy. The ultimate goal of this work is to develop innovative and equitable design pedagogies that equip various socio-economic, diverse, marginalized, and undeserved community members to learn and apply design to their lives, conceivably empowering vibrant living. The research, produced in tandem with college design students, engages through community design-oriented workshops, placemaking efforts, design thinking sessions, and various qualitative research practices. Outcomes are shared, experienced, and modeled through versatile tool kits and sustainable solutions pointing to the numerous systemic social issues we face as community members. Lastly, my research is central to designing students' learning by applying first-hand facilitation, co-design practices, human-centered design, design thinking, and implementation skills while building real-life experience.
